

Format of the Tab Delimited Files for Importing in to ESGI

1. Files must be in **text format**
2. Files must consist of **columns of data separated with tabulation symbol**. (tab delimited txt file)
3. The **first line must contain the exact column names**.
4. Every entry must be unique. If there is a teacher or student with more than one teacher ID or student ID, this will cause an error.
5. The files must contain only teachers that will use ESGI and their students. There should not be any extra entries.

Import Files Format: Exact column header and description

1. **Teachers.txt**
 - TchID – Teacher Unique ID (alpha – numeric)*
 - SchCode – School Unique ID (alpha – numeric)
 - TchFN – Teacher Firstname
 - TchLN – Teacher Lastname
 - Email – Teacher Email
 - UserName – Teacher Login
2. **Students.txt**
 - StulID – Student Unique ID (alpha – numeric)
 - FirstName - Student Firstname
 - LastName - Student Lastname
 - Gender – Gender.
 - HomeLang – Student Home Language
3. **Rostering.txt**
 - StulID – Student Unique ID (alpha – numeric)**
 - TchID – Teacher Unique ID (alpha – numeric)
 - SchCode – School Unique ID (alpha – numeric)
 - Grade – Grade Level
